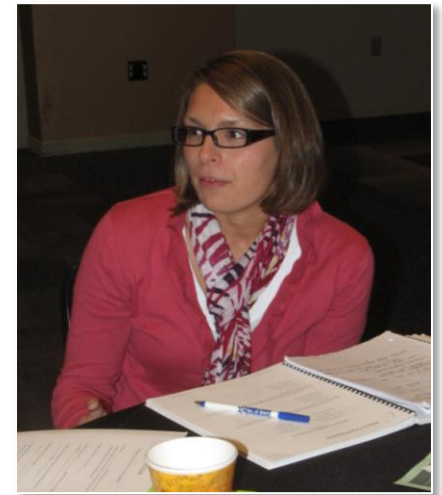


You are Invited to Join us for a Professional Development Seminar in Phoenix/Mesa
